Doctoral students must complete the web-based *Course in the Protection of Human Research Subjects* through the Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI). There is no cost to you for this training. This training consists of eight modules that include readings, case studies, and quizzes. You must score 80% to receive a completion report.

Directions

1. To begin the online course, visit the [CITI website](#) and select “Create an Account” and click “Register.”
2. Enter the University of Houston as your institution, and Continue to Step 2
3. Enter your personal information and email address.
4. Create a username and password.
5. Click “Complete Registration” and “Finalize Registration.”
6. On the main menu page under courses, select this course: **Group 2: Human Subject Research-Social and Behavioral Research Investigators and Graduate Students.**
7. Click “Complete the Integrity Assurance Statement before beginning the course” and submit.
8. Complete the training.
9. Take a screenshot of the “Coursework Requirements Report” and send to your advisor.
